Discussion And Possible Action On Milton Area Veterans Memorial Bricks For Civil War Veterans

The commission discussed the selling of bricks for Civil War Veterans at possibly a reduced rate and questioned how many names could be placed on one brick. Comm. Bostwick is going to work with Pechmann Memorials on determining answers to the commissions questions.

2019 Work Plan

a. Discussion And Possible Action On Bike Racks On City Property

The commission selected the bike rack style, and requested Director Cushman obtain a price quote for two bike racks to be installed in North Goodrich Park and South Goodrich Park.

b. Discussion And Possible Action On Addition Of Playground Equipment To Water Tower Park

The commission discussed a potential budget for this project and what features they would like added to the park. The commission is looking at spending around \$15,000 on equipment. Director Cushman will research options with the various playground companies.

Director Robinson stated he has a potential volunteer to assist with the Eagle Scout project at Mud Lake, and that there is potential to receive a \$1,000 grant from ATC.


Set Next Meeting Date
