Public Safety Forum
August 4, 2016

- “Peeping Tom”: Have complainants call the police department
- Update from Milton School District on parking
 - Milton East project nearing completion. Communication on flow going to parents soon.
 - District considering parking improvement at Schilberg Park, but no school board approved projects as of now.
 - Traffic flow at Milton West was discussed
- Parking on Parkview between High and Madison
 - Suggestion by business owner to eliminate angle parking and reconfigure city lot for one way traffic
- Corner of Serns Road and Lukas Lane: Dirt pile and weeds obstructing views for those at the intersection
- Speeding on East Sunset and Northside.
- Rounding off the intersection of Serns and John Paul
- Frequent stop sign violations at Blanche and Brown intersection
- Suggestion to add stop sign at Sunset and Northside
- Using speed “humps” in residential areas with speed issues
- Increase no parking area at John Paul and Madison Avenue
- Eliminate no parking on High Street between Janesville and Chicago Street
- Rodents causing damage to residences
- Staffing discussion for fire department and police department
- Increasing school busing to improve safety
- Bike helmet initiatives
