Subject: Discussion and Possible Action on Proposals for 2019-2021 Sludge Hauling

Discussion and Background

The City advertised for the submittal of sludge hauling proposals in the Milton Courier and local contractors were notified. The Public Works Department opened proposals on 2/28/2019.

Proposals were as follows:

Bytec has the low proposal per year and for a 3 year total. We have worked with them as our exiting contractor and the operators are happy with their work.

They have proposed an additional 2 year extension at a 3% increase per year, which closely matches their proposed amount. Extending the contract would result in the following prices:
 Year 2022 \$.036/Gallon
 Year 2023 \$.038/Gallon

Recommendation

Staff recommends accepting the 3 year proposal from Bytec for sludge hauling services. Additionally, staff recommends extending the contract for 2 additional years per their proposal.
