made history at the polls Tuesday as a clear cut majority voted to consolidate the two villages into one village. The consolidation will take effect next April. A turnout of 1,093 voters cast ballots in the two villages Tuesday and approved the referendum by a solid 72 per

The vote in Milton was \$15 to 47 in favor of the merger, 92 per cent, while in Milton Junction the vote was \$22 to 201 in favor. A solid and vocal core of opposition to the merger existed in Milton Junction but the vote favoring the merger represented \$2\$ per cent of the

As a result of the consolida entire community will be entit ton, effective next April.

As proposed in unanimous retolutions by the two village touch a month ago, the two village will continue to operate independently until April when the regular spring elections are held. A single village tourn will then be elected at large to meet the problems of uniting various municipal services and to prepare for the forwation of a city government as toon as practicable.

All village ordinances presently in effect in both villages will remain in effect until they are cancelled or replaced by the new single village.
