2023 Collection Schedules

Weekly REFUSE collection date for the ENTIRE city is every WEDNESDAY.

RECYCLING is collected EVERY-OTHER week according to the collection calendar on the back.

REFUSE AND RECYCLING

Johns Disposal is the provider for refuse and recycling collection. Refuse and recycling carts and bulky trash shall NOT be placed at the curb earlier than 6 p.m. on the evening before the scheduled collection and must be out by 6 a.m. on collection day.

The arrows on the lids must point to the street, and handles and wheels should face away from the street. Both carts should be within 2 feet of the street and 6 feet apart. Be sure there is 6 feet of clearance with any other objects, especially mailboxes and vehicles. ONLY items inside the carts will be picked up on your weekly service day.

Bulky Trash Collection

A change is coming to your bulk items collection in 2023. **Effective January 1, residents must call Johns Disposal (262-473-4700 or 888-473-4701) to schedule your bulk items collections.** You will still receive up to one collection per month at no additional charge. However, collections will now be made any week of the month – no more waiting until the 3rd Wednesday for pickup. Bulk items collection includes items that do not fit in your garbage or recycling cart, such as: furniture, extra bags of garbage, tires (up to two per month, maximum eight per year), waste oil (must be in 1 gallon or larger containers, sealed, and labeled), etc.

COMPOST AND YARD WASTE DROP-OFF SITE

April 1 - November 30

Compost and yard waste may be put in the designated container at the Public Works Facility located at 150 Northside Drive. Available for City of Milton residents only. Contractors are NOT allowed to use this service. Waste must be put into containers. No dumping on ground unless dumpsters are completely full. All non-biodegradable containers must be emptied and taken home or placed in the trash can next to the drop-off site.

Accepted Items: Grass clippings, leaves, small twigs, raw garden waste, tree seeds, pine cones, flowering plants and other materials deemed acceptable by a Public Works representative.

Non-Accepted Items: Food waste, tree branches, firewood, plastic bags, paper bags, cardboard, trash and other items deemed unacceptable by a Public Works representative.

BRUSH CURBSIDE

Monthly April to November (weather permitting).

Collection will be the first Monday of every month listed below.

April 3 | May 1 | June 5* | July 5 | August 7

September 5 | October 2 | November 6**

**Pick up will start on Wednesday due to holiday.*

***Pick up will start on Tuesday due to holiday.*

2022 Christmas tree pick-up - Week of December 26, 2022

2023 Christmas tree pick-up - Week of January 2, 2024

Brush must be at the curb by 6 a.m. on the day of collection to ensure pick up. Brush collection is for brush trimmed by the homeowner only, not by private contractors. NO compost, weeds, root balls, yard waste, barrels, lumber, furniture, bags or boxes of brush, or materials containing metal will be collected. Limbs may not exceed 8 inches in diameter. Brush is to be stacked butt end towards the street in the terrace or right-of-way pointing the same direction as the flow of traffic in piles no more than 4 feet high. If it is not stacked nicely, it will not be collected. Brush shall not be placed in the street or curb area. All Christmas trees must be free of all items (stands, tinsel, lights, ornaments, etc.) or they will not be collected. Staff will chip brush for up to one hour at each parcel. **If brush remains after one hour, staff will stop and the resident or owner will be notified. Chipping may continue upon authorization of the resident or owner if they agree to pay for additional staff and equipment time beyond one hour.**

SPRING YARD WASTE CURBSIDE

April 1 - 30

Must have material in an open container no heavier than 50 pounds. Paper yard waste bags are acceptable. Plastic bags and paper grocery bags are not. Maximum capacity is 30-gallons. 55-gallon drums will not be emptied. Only materials from City of Milton residents and businesses will be picked up.

FALL LEAVES CURBSIDE

October 9 - November 17

Curbside collection for leaves will occur in the fall as weather permits. **Only leaves will be collected.** Rake the leaves into the curb area of the street at any time during this period. Do NOT rake leaves into the curb area of the street after November 17.
